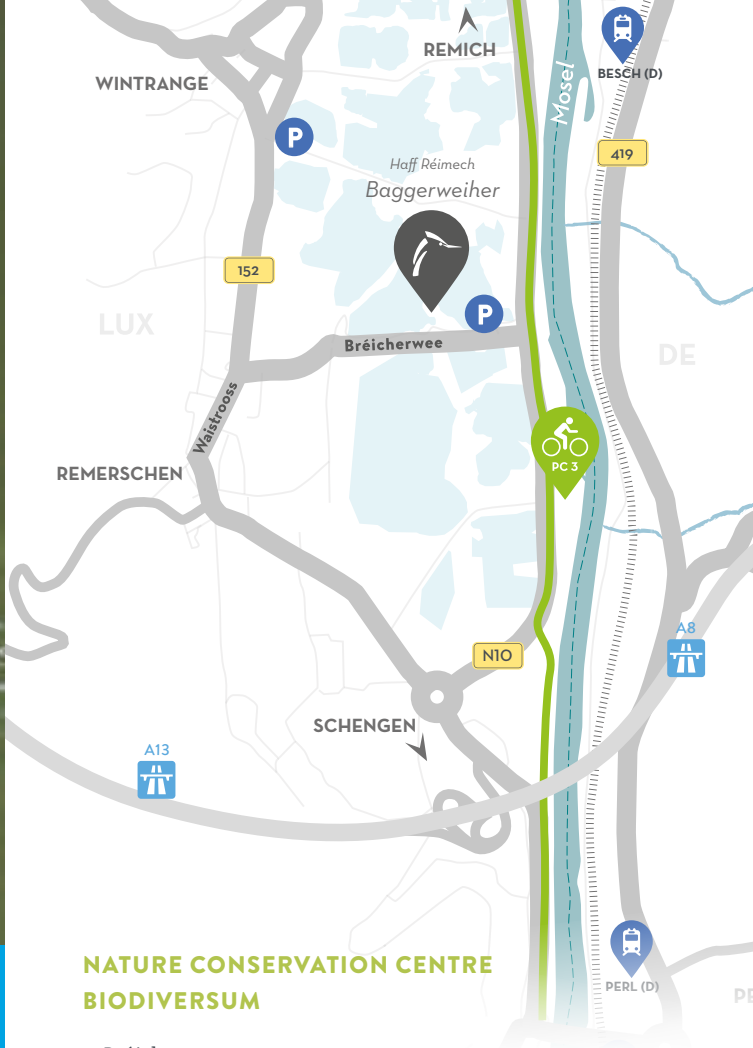

for many bird species“

- Most species-rich wetland of Luxembourg: on just about 0,1 % of the country's total area up to 76 % of the bird species reported in Luxembourg have been detected here
- National and international bird reserve (Ramsar site and Natura 2000 habitat)
- Resting area for many protected migratory bird species during their journey
- Nature discovery trail and several observation huts

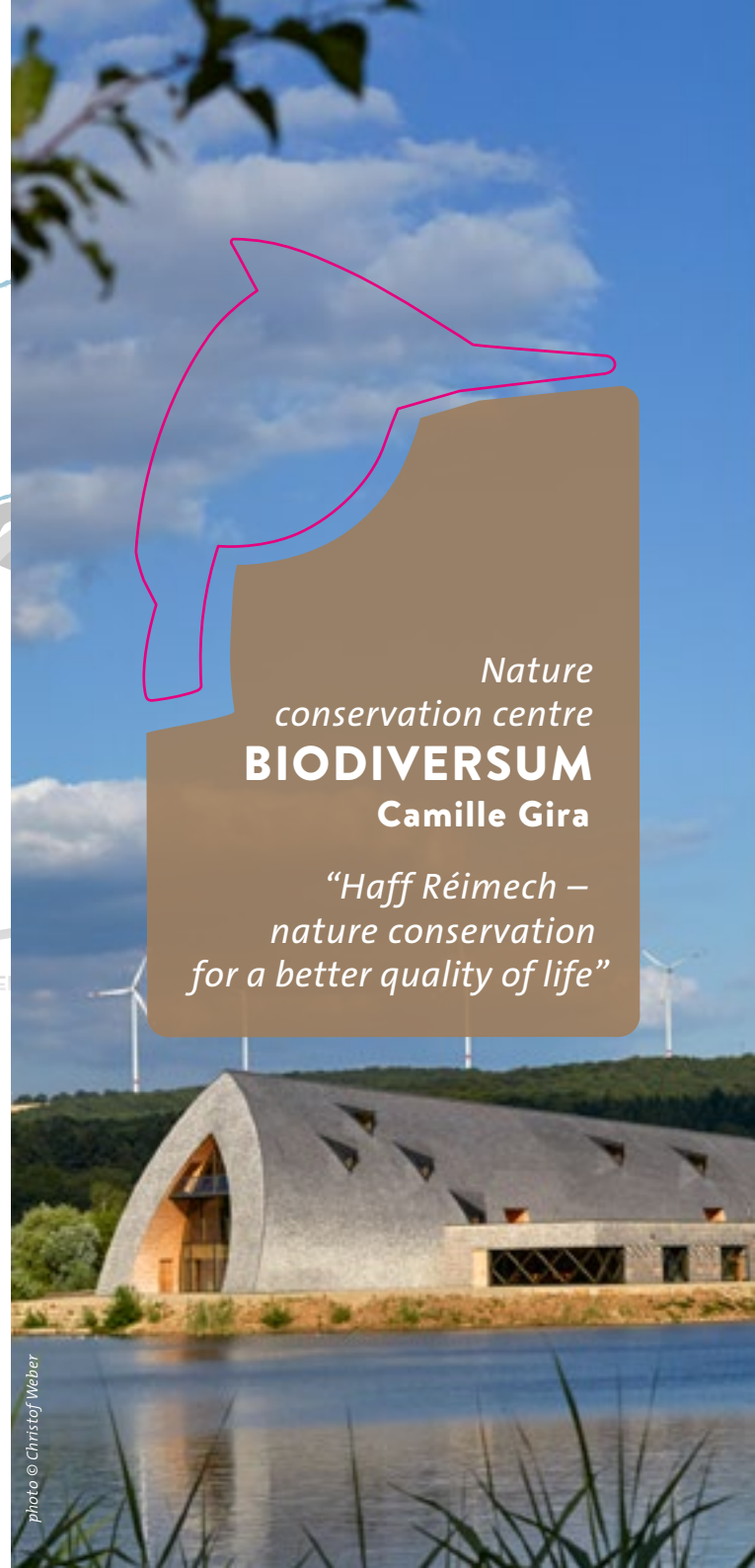
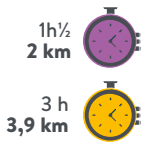
